





Our ultra low sulphur wax sets supreme standards



It is therefore important to comply with these quality standards. However, it is even better to exceed them. Because we always aspire to keep improving what is good, we are proud to introduce, after intensive research and development work, Ultra Low Sulphur Wax, or ULSW for short.

The special feature of this type of paraffin is that it contains extremely low levels of sulphur: a maximum of 10 milligrams of sulphur per kilo, a value that is classified as sulphur free in the fuel industry. This is a unique feature that appeals to all those who accept no compromises on issues of health and the environment.



Sasol Wax is ensuring the future by investing in FT waxes. As petroleum based waxes become less abundant, we are improving our supply of Fischer-Tropsch waxes (FT waxes for short). This is why we are increasingly offering our customers FT waxes in addition to our petroleum based waxes.

There are good reasons for this: firstly, FT waxes are produced in a fully synthetic process and hence independently of oil. At the same time, they have the quality and properties of paraffins – and can be used with equal versatility. In addition to this, FT waxes are the purest raw materials that can be used for the production of candles.


